Bev moves to remove "Low Intensity Recreation" from the bylaw entirely. Andrew seconds. Motion Passes unanimously

Andrew moves to approve the changes made to the "Productive Lands." Bev seconds. Motion Passes unanimously

Bev moves to take numbers out of the uses sections of all districts and rely on the clarification of the definitions in the Zoning Bylaw with the exception of multi-family dwelling. Maria seconds Motion Passes unanimously
