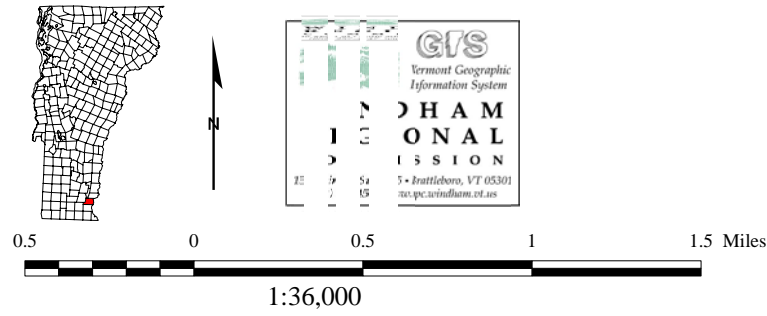


Conserved and Working Lands (with existing development)

Sources:

- Parcel lines are from GIS data developed by Cartographic Technologies, Inc. (CTI), Brattleboro, Vt., and are current to 2005. These data are based upon original VGIS parcel data generated by scanning Dummerston's 1:5000 scale tax maps.

- Data on lands under conservation protection were obtained from WRC mapping, the Town of Dummerston, the Vermont Conserved Lands Database, and the Vermont Land Trust. Data are current to 2009.

- Data on parcels enrolled in the Use Value Appraisal Program (i.e. "current use program") in 2007 were compiled using information from the Dummerston grand list.

- Structure locations were captured using Global Positioning System technology by microDATA, St. Johnsbury, VT for Vermont's Enhanced 9-1-1 program. Locations have been edited by Windham Regional Commission in 2005 and 2009 using 2000 Vermont digital orthophotos and National Agricultural Imagery Program orthophotos.
