Minutes Dummerston Energy Committee Monday, March 7, 2022 @ 6pm Online via Zoom

- 1. Meeting was called to order at 6:00pm:
 - a. Calvin Farwell, Doug Morton, and Alex Wilson were in attendance.
- 2. Welcomed guests: No guests present.
- 3. Reviewed agenda: No new items.
- 4. Approved minutes from the February 7, 2022 meeting:
 - a. Motioned by Doug; seconded by Alex; unanimously approved.
- 5. Covered bridge lights:
 - a. No new updates.
- 6. Federal infrastructure bill what does it mean for Vermont and Dummerston?:

- a. Doug reported that, according to the ARPA state-to-local funding table,
 Dummerston will receive a total of \$182,575.44 in two equal payments, the first coming this August.
- b. ARPA includes four broad criteria outlining eligible uses: 1) To respond to the public health emergency or its negative economic impacts, including assistance to households, small businesses, and nonprofits, or aid to impacted industries such as tourism, travel, and hospitality; 2) To respond to workers performing essential work during the COVID-19 public health emergency by providing premium pay to eligible workers; 3) For the provision of government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue due to the COVID-19 public health

- emergency relative to revenues collected in the most recent full fiscal year prior to the emergency; and 4) To make necessary investments in water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure.
- c. We discussed further Alex's idea for using these funds to build a sewage treatment system for West Dummerston Village, which has experienced failing private septic systems, and perhaps work with the new owners of Maple Valley to do so; it does appear that this project would meet the criteria for use of these funds (see #4 above); but it was agreed by all that this initiative should be proposed by resident(s) of that village, and could then be considered by the Selectboard.
- d. ACTION: Doug will reach out to the Selectboard to ask about their general plans and process for the use of these funds.

7. Electric vehicles (EVs) and eBikes:

- a. The proposed Buyers Guide continues on hold, as we are trying to determine the best form for it to take.
- b. ACTION: Eric and Doug will continue to coordinate with Kevin about the project and any expected website needs.

8. BikePed project proposal:

a. Background: Daniel Hovis from Putney is working with towns in Southern VT to implement a series of bike/pedestrian improvements (trails and paths with interconnections to other towns); he suggests setting up a committee to advise the town's Selectboard as the first step; the Bellows Falls Selectboard has already voted to implement such a committee; he is hoping that someone from the Conservation Commission or Energy Committee can facilitate that effort for Dummerston.

- b. ACTION: We will look at this more in depth for a future meeting to see if there is any interest, and then make recommendations for moving forward.
