## Minutes Dummerston Energy Committee Monday, June 6, 2022 @ 6pm Online via Zoom

- 1. Meeting was called to order at 6:07pm:
  - a. Eric Lineback, Calvin Farwell, and Alex Wilson were in attendance.
- 2. Welcomed guests: No guests present.
- 3. Reviewed agenda: No new items.
- 4. Approved minutes from the May 2, 2022 meeting:
  - a. Motioned by Alex; seconded by Calvin; unanimously approved.
- 5. Covered bridge lights:
  - a. Stan has not yet been able to install the remaining lights; he will continue the install as he's available to do so.
  - b. Once the new lights are all installed and in use for some time, we will look at energy usage of the new set-up versus the old one.

- 6. Federal infrastructure bill what does it mean for Dummerston?:
  - a. The SB has requested project ideas for the \$521,000 that the town will receive.
  - b. We have inquired about the evaluation criteria to be used in selecting projects and are considering various ideas (for example, EV charging stations, home energy audits, weatherization projects, etc.).
  - c. ACTION: Alex and Doug will continue looking into possibly using some of these funds to build a wastewater treatment system for West Dummerston Village. See next item (#7).
- 7. West Dummerston Village wastewater project proposal:

- Alex and Doug have done some initial research; they have been in touch with the WRC, Bob Stevens, Tom Brown at the ANR, and Zig Zboray in Jacksonville.
- b. There is state funding available for a feasibility study and initial design work.
- c. ACTION: Alex and Doug will continue their research.
- 8. Electric vehicles (EVs) and eBikes:
  - a. No updates.
- 9. Efficiency Vermont town energy assessment:
  - a. Eric informed the committee that the SB has applied for the assessment.
  - b. ACTION: Eric will reach out to Zeke for an update.
