## Minutes Dummerston Energy Committee Monday, February 5, 2024 @ 5:30pm Online via Zoom

- 1. Meeting was called to order at 5:33pm:
  - a. Eric Lineback, Calvin Farwell, Alex Wilson, and Thomas Nolan were in attendance.
- 2. Welcomed guests:
  - a. Lee Chamberlin was present.
- 3. Reviewed agenda:
  - a. No new items were added.
- 4. Approved minutes from the January 8, 2024 meeting:
  - a. Motioned by Calvin; seconded by Thomas; unanimously approved.
- 5. Town garage lighting report:
  - a. We reviewed the report with Lee and discussed next steps.
  - b. We discussed funding options, including remaining ARPA funds, MERP funding, EV grants/rebates, existing DEC funds, and highway department budgeted maintenance funds.
  - c. We discussed using local vendors when and if possible.
