Librarian's Report:

New resources: Karen announced that the library is now participating in the State Library's online database resource, called Vermont Online Library (VOL). Patrons can now search dozens of databases on topics such as genealogy, literature, history, science, or enroll in hundreds of online courses, including language classes. VOL is accessed through the library's website. Karen is developing a handout for the public with information on how to access the databases, which should be ready for Town Meeting Day. The United Ways of Vermont have developed a telephone information resource, 211, which can help the public find services available locally on a wide range of concerns, including employment and veteran services. Brochures are available at the library.

Karen has put links on the library's Facebook page to reading challenges for adult readers.

Old Business:

New Business

Town Meeting: Discussion of having a library table for book bag sales and for informational handouts.
