I've received an invoice from him, but we haven't secured permission to hold the program yet, and we haven't paid him yet, as we haven't received the grant money. This program will be FREE and everyone will be invited to attend. For free. Because we are a *public* library.
- No one showed up for the last knitting group, except me. So, I want to change the time of this program from a Tuesday evening once a month to a Saturday Morning to see if that works better. The next meeting of the knitting club will be on Saturday, May 27.
- There was a question about whether we would be hosting StoryWalks this year, and whether we could have one for the fundraiser event in May. I don't know if we have to ask permission to do this or not. Questions about things like this that seemed settled in the past no longer seem quite as settled.

• Outreach

- I attended the Arts Night program at the Dummerston School on Thursday, April 13th. I introduced myself and the library, and two families (two kids each) signed up for library cards.
- I'll be looking to do the new baby book dedications for Dummerston's 2022 babies soon.
- The Friends Group, Lydia's Friends has been planning a fundraiser event in May.

• Library
