#### **Approval of Last Month's Meeting Minutes**

## **Treasurer's Report**

- -Future budgets will not include contributions made by Lydia's Friends.
- -Substitute librarian costs will need to come from other expenses in the budget, not the librarian's salary.
- -The librarian has increased the programming budget from \$500 to \$800.
- -The library's rent will increase by 64% for the 2025/2026 budget.
- -Town support for the library will increase by 17% for the 2025/2026 year.

A motion was made by Dave to approve this month's warrant, which was seconded by Lyle, and the motion passed.

  - Story Time mostly continues to happen weekly, thanks to a group of volunteers. There will be no Story Time on Thursday, September 5. We have about 4 kids regularly attending, and a handful of others who come sometimes. We've publicized the program via the library newsletter, the library facebook page, posts to Dummerston and Putney Facebook pages, Front Porch Forum, the Dummerston School newsletter, etc.
- Three Museum Passes (Magic Wings, VINS, and Montshire Museum) have been made available and publicized, thanks to funding provided by Lydia's Friends. Plans are to acquire additional passes in the coming months, including the Eric Carle Museum, MassMOCA, and others.
