

This meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Town Office in Dummerston Center, Vermont.

A motion was made and passed to approve the minutes of May 28, 2003 and to pay Warrants 25 & 25P.

Bids were opened for the slope stabilization on Camp Arden Road:

Thad and the Board spoke with Mike Renaud and discussed the plans and bid he submitted. Mike estimated this would be a two week project. Thad will review the bids; Thad will also speak with Floyd Roberts and funding from FEMA needs to be addressed.

The highway department has been scraping roads, working on trucks and gravel has been put on Kipling Road. Roadside mowing will begin on July 1st and will take approximately three weeks. The statement for repairs from Nortrax, Inc. was discussed and some charges were questioned. Paul will write a letter and send a copy of the bid specs to them for their review. The old generator will be advertised for sale on the Vermont League and Cities and Towns website.

A motion was made and passed to sign a curb cut permit for David Baker. Location: the bottom of the hill on East-West Road East near the bridge.

A motion was made and passed to sign the contract with the Windham County Humane Society, dated June, 2003.

Eesha William's request regarding a bulletin board was discussed. Budasi/Morris letter re plowing on Hague Road: this area will be reviewed on the annual road tour and Wayne stated this road is one of the first roads to be plowed; he will try to address any problems in that area.
