# **Approved Minutes**

**January 3, 2012** 

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 at the Dummerston Town Office by Cynthia Wilcox

1. Public Invited to make comments

2. Conversations with John Bennett, Windham Regional Commission; Charlotte Annis, zoning administrator and Alan McBean, prior zoning administrator, regarding Dummerston's Zoning Bylaw, recommendations for its amendment and for best uses of the Municipal Planning Grant to that end.

Alan McBean was not able to attend.

John talked about the planning process. Dummerston has a number of moving parts. He has worked with the Bylaw subcommittee. There is also the corridor study going on. Municipal Planning grant involves draft language revisions for the bylaw and mapping. There are about 80 hours of WRC time left, with 20 hours reserved for the mapping. This leaves somewhere around 60 hours for John to devote to helping the DPC with the bylaws. State needs to see a completed hearing draft of bylaws for the purpose of the grant. This needs to be done by May 15 but it would be good to be done sooner. The key pieces are the boundaries and land uses for the districts.

John suggests that a good way to start working on revisions to Article 2 is to look at the existing map and look at future land use map to describe what the boundaries should be in general.

Appropriate order of decision that needs to be made:

- Define districts
- Define uses
- Define boundaries
- Define densities

John is the keeper of the Bylaw draft. Best way to use John's time might not always be attending meetings. He suggests a mixture of attending DPC meetings and meeting with a subset of DPC during the day.

Bill suggests that each person take on responsibility for learning about a single district thus becoming the DPC's point person. Still, we all need to be familiar with the current zoning and the reason for a departure from the current bylaw.

The DPC charged John Bennett with drafting bylaw language and format for each of the districts described in the Town Plan, with the uses as put together in the Matrix, to leave a blank spot for densities, and to insert questions as they occur to him. In addition the DPC asked him to indicate if he sees issues in the Town Plan. He will do this by January 12<sup>th</sup>.

Andrew moves that those who are willing to take a district and learn it where we've been and where we need to go based on the town plan. Cynthia seconds. Motion passes.

DPC members divided the task as follows:

Andrew: Rural

Annamarie: Residential

Bill: Resource and Ag Overlay, Connecting Habitats

Cindy: Historic Settlement

**Deb: Conservation** 

Sam: Commercial/Industrial Steve: Rural Commercial

Charlotte reports on these issues that she sees for the bylaw revision. DPC needs to look at how non-conformities are addressed in Dummerston, also Home business, waivers, Certificates of Occupancy and subdivisions.

In discussions of Home Enterprise bylaw before we decided to table it we agreed that during our 12/15 we had reached a consensus that there needs to be a "grandfathering" mechanism for existing businesses to get permits during a set time period without a DRB hearing
