#### Call to Order

#### -Budget Report

- \$1700 in grants was received during the last fiscal year.

- Last year the library received around double the amount of donations from the Annual Appeals than in recent years.
- The library received a generous donation from the Dummerston Community Chest again this year, in the amount of \$1400.

Sue motioned to approve the most recent warrant, which was seconded by Dave, and the motion passed.
