

SELECTBOARD MEETING      FEBRUARY 19, 2003      7:30 P.M.

This meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Town Office in Dummerston Center, Vermont.

Members Present: Paul Normandeau, Chairman; Shorty Forrett, Vice-Chairman; Lester Dunklee, Clerk; Jack Manix and Cindy Jerome.

Also Present: Road Foreman Wayne Emery, Fire Chief Allen Pike, Emergency Management Director Larry Lynch, Lori Tkaczyk, Mary Copeland, Ed Anthes.

A motion was made and passed to approve the minutes of February 5<sup>th</sup> and to sign Warrants 17 & 17P.

After some discussion, a motion was made and passed not to hold a Pre-Town Meeting.

Shorty is going to invite newly elected Windham County Sheriff Shelia Prue to the Selectboard meeting on April 2, 2003.

After a lengthy discussion a motion was made and passed to send a letter to Albie Lewis, Vermont Emergency Management Director, stating we are not signing the revised ENTERGY NUCLEAR EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN until several concerns are addressed. Concerns are: Need for additional personnel to man the EOC for rotating positions for extended periods of time during an incident; time needed to notify residents of an incident is not realistic; distribution of weather alert radios; status of an automatic dialing system to notify residents; transportation resources for evacuation; testing notification and evacuation plans; dosages of Potassium Iodide are contradictory in different parts of the plan. Who, where and how do people obtain re-entry passes. Dummerston EOC has only one dedicated phone line for fax. The other phone line is shared with the Town Office. Dummerston EOC should have copies of plans used in town from campground.

Wayne: The 550 Ford lost it's automatic transmission Again! It has been repaired and back in service. The crew has started winging back snow banks and will begin making cut outs. The Town has only enough salt for one more storm. The Board authorized Wayne to order another truck load of salt. The septic line at the Town Garage has frozen twice.

Shorty made a motion to appoint Daniel Marx to the Connecticut River Joint Commission. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned 10:20 PM.
