Minutes:

Warrants:

On a motion by Maria and second from Alex the Board voted 4-0 to approve payment of warrants 13, 13P & Recreation Board Fund #3. Warrant 13 includes ARPA expenditures.

ARPA Funding:

The Board received a request from Lee to cover some of the repair cost for the 2017 Western Star transmission.

On a motion by Maria and second from Todd the Board voted 4-0 to allocate the remaining ARPA funds of \$3,269.68 to the repair costs for the Western Star truck transmission.

Public Comments:

Gail Sorenson thanked the Board for posting the budget on the Town website. Paul Normandeau asked if the structures were critical or planned repair/updates, and could there be any slack in that area of the budget.

Road Foreman's Report:

Gail and Paul N. asked if applicant names could be printed regarding DRB hearing notices and Act 250 notices. Maria stated they could, however in the past names have usually been omitted. Todd could add a link on the agenda for any of the Act 250 information.

Paul received a revised Sheriff's contract to include the additional hours funded by ARPA money. The Board prefers to have a separate contract just for the additional hours.
